RE: Delegation of Authority – Authority to Approve Hiring of Near-Relatives

Effective immediately, as Chancellor and pursuant to the authority delegated to me, I delegate the following authority to you:

- Authority to approve the employment of near relatives in the same department, provided that such concurrent employment would be in the best interests of the University.
(source of authority: Academic Personnel Manual, APM-520)

Internal department protocols must be followed prior to making a hiring commitment. If the Provost and Executive Vice Chancellor is the Hiring Manager (usually the supervisor for the posted position), Chancellor's approval is required.

This delegation is subject to all other University and Merced Campus policies and procedures. Exercise of this authority shall be subject to the conditions set forth in the academic personnel policy on employment of near relatives (Academic Personnel Manual, APM-520). This authority may not be further re-delegated by you.
