PROVOST AND EXECUTIVE VICE CHANCELLOR (P/EVC)

RE: Delegation of Authority (DA) – Academic Personnel Manual (APM) Section APM-240, Appointment and Promotion, Deans

In accordance with the Academic Personnel Manual (APM) Section APM-100-d, Chancellors may re-delegate authority for implementation of academic personnel policies unless otherwise restricted. APM-240 pertains to appointment, reappointment, and conditions of employment of deans. Pursuant to the policy, deans serve at the discretion of the Chancellor and the Chancellor may re-delegate the authority for implementation of the policy to a designee.

Effective immediately, as Chancellor and pursuant to the authority delegated to me, I delegate the following authority to you:

- Authority to appoint, reappoint and remove faculty members as deans at any time, with or without cause.
 - It is my expectation that before any faculty member is removed as dean, you will consult with the faculty of the School and Academic Senate as required by section 240-20 of the APM.
 - Subject to all other University and Merced campus policies and procedures.
- Source of authority: APM 100-d, General University Policy Regarding Academic Appointees, and APM-240, Appointment and Promotion of Deans.

This authority may not be further re-delegated.

This authority supersedes any previous delegation on the subject.
